



## **Canoe England Job Description Club Coach Educators – Part time**

### **Purpose of Posts:**

To provide affordable and accessible coach education training for club volunteers working to support and develop quality coach delivery for young paddlers across the paddler pathway.

**Locations:** Team Central and Team South

### **Role**

To deliver on behalf of Canoe England coach education courses on a regional basis to include:

- BCU Level 1 Coach
- BCU Level 2 Coach Training
- BCU Level 2 Assessment
- Discipline specific Modules

### **General**

Each post will have an agreed minimum number of courses to deliver in a 12 month period. This may be increased depending on demand and the availability of the successful candidates. In the first instance we are looking to deliver 12 courses per team.

The contract will initially be for one year – on review of the success this may be extended subject to funding.

Payment will be based on a per day basis of £150 per day plus travel and accommodation costs at the current Canoe England scales of reimbursement.

The programme of work will be agreed with the appropriate Canoe England Senior Development Officer and National Competition Development Coaches.

### **Person Specification**

The successful candidates will have BCU Training Director status with experience of delivery of the BCU Level 1 and 2 coach education delivery and or the ability to deliver the BCU Discipline specific modules.
