



Hare & Hound

Venue: St. Denys Community Centre
Horse Shoe Bridge
Southampton

The Hare and Hounds is a series of races held monthly, being run by Southampton Canoe Club over the winter. It is based on a time trial format. Everybody is welcome to take part in any type of kayak or canoe. The slowest paddlers start first, and then each individual's time is taken into account and set off accordingly with the aim of everybody finishing at the same time. This makes for a very exciting event, in which no one is left behind on the water. There are two distances from which to choose: 2 miles (1 long lap) and 5 miles (2 long laps and 1 short lap)

First event date: 27th November 2011
Second event date: 11th December 2011
Third event date: 29th January 2012

Short course: Start at St Denys slipway, paddle upstream to the reeds by Bitterne Park. Turn anti-clockwise at the red buoy and finish by St Denys slipway.

Long course: Paddle 2 laps of the short course turning at the pontoon, level with the slipway. Then paddle upstream to Cobden bridge, turn anti-clockwise and finish at the slipway.

Check in: 09:30am.
Briefing: 10:00am
First start: 10:30am

Entry fee: £2.00

Prizes will be given to those in singles who show the most improvement over the series. The finishing time for one event is the relative start time for the next.

Parking for this event is on-road, on Horse Shoe Bridge.
